



RWD *Riverhead Water District*

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DEVELOPERS REQUESTING WATER MAIN EXTENSIONS SHOULD SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO THE RIVERHEAD WATER DISTRICT FOR REVIEW:

The first step in applying for water is to make application to the water district with a preliminary site plan, survey. This information must include the tax map designation and proposed subdivision layout and scope of the proposed project. We then respond with a letter requesting funding for the extension report (outside of district) or lateral extension report (inside boundaries).

Once money is deposited, a map and plan is prepared, presented to the town board for approval. Then this report is submitted to the DEC if a boundary extension is required.

Once the Town Board and DEC approvals are received, the developer funds are deposited for design and construction.
