### SUFFOLK COUNTY AQUACULTURE LEASE BOARD MEETINGS

Notice is hereby given that the Suffolk County Aquaculture Lease Board will conduct two public meetings to review and consider the 52 sites identified in lease applications that were submitted under the 2017 Lease Application Cycle; and the three sites that were submitted in one Lease Relocation application. The first meeting, to be held on Friday, June 30, 2017 beginning at 3:00 p.m. in the Division of Planning and Environment, Second Floor Conference Room, H. Lee Dennison Bldg., 100 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, NY, will be devoted to presentation of all 55 lease sites submitted, and review of all written comments on these sites that have been received by the Division of Planning and Environment during the 60-day public notice period. The public will also be given the opportunity to present comments orally and submit additional written testimony on the lease sites at this meeting.

The public is also invited to attend the second meeting of the Suffolk County Aquaculture Lease Board, which will be held on Wednesday, July 26, 2017 beginning at 3:00 p.m. in the Division of Planning and Environment, Second Floor Conference Room, H. Lee Dennison Bldg., 100 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, NY. The Aquaculture Lease Board will make its formal decision on which sites will be eligible for lease by Suffolk County at this meeting.
