WHEREAS, an application is being prepared to Suffolk County to provide funding for a Riverhead youth center in the amount of \$50,000 which shall consist of \$25,000 of County money to be matched by \$25,000 to Town money, and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Riverhead community supporting the construction of a Riverhead Youth Center have provided this Board with information which demonstrates the value of this project to the citizens of the Town of Riverhead.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and hereby is authorized to open and publicly read aloud said bids on Monday, March 12, 1984 at 11:00 a.m. at Riverhead Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, and to make a report of said bids to the Town Board at the next meeting following the opening of the bids.

#150 APPROVES SPECIAL PERMIT APPLICATION OF PECONIC WELDING & MEDICAL SUPPLY TO STORE COMPRESSED GASES

Councilman Artale offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Lombardi.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of September, 1983, Peconic Welding and Medical Supply did apply to this Town Board for a special permit to store compressed gases to supply various businesses at premises located at 1400 West Main Street, Riverhead, New York, and

WHEREAS, this matter was referred to the Planning Board for their review and recommendation, and

WHEREAS, by letter dated October 12, 1983, the Planning Board did recommend that the special permit application be approved subject to any restrictions, requirements and/or limitations as outlined in the Riverhead Town Code and any other applicable codes, and that a fire protection survey be compiled in conjunction with the Town of Riverhead Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by this Town Board on the 18th day of October, 1983, wherein all persons wishing to be heard were heard, and

WHEREAS, by letter dated the 7th day of February, 1984, the Board of Commissioners of the Riverhead Fire District did recommend to this Town Board that the application be approved, with the stipulation that the Building be clearly marked as to its contents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the special permit application of Peconic Welding and Medical Supply to store compressed gases to supply local businesses at premises located at 1400 West Main Street, Riverhead, New York, be and is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions:

1. That a fire protection survey be compiled in conjunction with the Town of Riverhead Fire Department;

2. That flammable materials be stored alone and oxygen and inert gases be stored in another area separated by a block wall.

3. That the applicant shall comply with all New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code rules and regulations, and well as National Fire Protection Association standards.

RESOLVED, that this special permit is subject to site plan approval by the Riverhead Town Board, and be it further


