#509 AUTHORIZES JAMESPORT FIRE DEPARTMENT TO USE STATE MARINA FOR THE NORTH FORK PARADE AND DRILL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Jamesport Fire Department be and is hereby authorized to use the State Marina in South Jamesport on Saturday, September 3, 1983, rain date Sunday, September 4, 1983, to host the North Fork Volunteer Firemen's Association parade and drill, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Jamesport Fire Department shall supply insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 naming the Town of Riverhead as additional insured, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the requirements of Chapter 46, Section 46-1 and 46-2 of the Riverhead Town Code pertaining to drinking alcoholic beverages on Town property be and are hereby waived on said date of such parade and drill, and be it further

RESOLVED, that this approval is subject to all the conditions, rules and regulations imposed by the State Liquor Authority, and be it further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded by the Town Clerk to the Jamesport Fire Department and to the Chief of Police of the Riverhead Police Department.
