#282 AUTHORIZES RECEIVER OF TAXES TO COLLECT SEWER RENTS

#283 AUTHORIZES SUPERVISOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACT OF SALE,  
RE: SEYMORE

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead has expressed its desire to purchase property located on Horton Avenue, Riverhead, New York, for the purpose of relocating residents and clearing delapidated buildings in that area through the Community Development Office, and

WHEREAS, Christine Seymore has expressed her desire to sell her real property located in that area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized to execute the subject contract wherein said sale is subject to a permissive referendum, and wherein the price of said parcel is \$10,000 to be paid from Community Development Funds, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is authorized to publish and post this resolution as follows:
