#498 AUTHORIZES SUPERVISOR TO SIGN AGREEMENT

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to publish and post the following Help Wanted Ad.

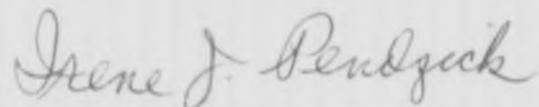
HELP WANTEDPurchasing Technician
