Supervisor Zaloga asked if anyone wished to be heard and the following responded:

Mr. Jacob Harding appeared before the Board to answer the Petition of 35 taxpayers re removal of tree in front of Mrs. Rusty King's premises at 120 Hallock Street. Mr. Harding stated that the Petition does not state the truth and again asked the Town Board to make an inspection of the area as the tree does not obstruct the driveway. Mr. Harding further stated that the tree in question is a large stately swamp maple, which provides cover, adds beauty to the area and is free of disease.

Town Attorney John J. Munzel suggested that the matter be referred to the Superintendent of Highways in accordance with Section 322 of the Highway Law.

Mr. John Riesdorff talked to the Board about the crowded areas of the Town Dump and suggested that the Board consider the provision of an area for burning the debris brought in by contractors operating in the business of dismantling and wrecking old houses.

Mr. Riesdorff also asked the Town Board to look into the matter of the garbage collector who has notified clients that if pick-ups fall on a holiday, the client's garbage will not be taken up until the next regular pick-up.

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PERSONAL APPEARANCES continued:

Mr. Boris Bagdassaroff, Shade Tree Lane, Aquebogue, talked to the Town Board on the lack of equity for mobile home owners and their having no alternative when asked to move and stated the Town Board will be hearing more on the matter in the near future.

DEPARTMENT HEADS

Capt. Roscoe Palmer requested the Town Board to schedule a meeting for the purpose of drawing up new rules and procedures for the Police Department.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

The basis of the future assessments of all future costs of operation, maintenance and improvements is ad valorem.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and shall take effect on or about the 17th day of December, 1970 unless a permissive referendum be demanded, in which event it shall take effect pursuant to the provisions of Section 206 of the Town Law of the State of New York, and


