PUBLIC HEARING - 10:45 A.M.

Town Clerk submitted affidavits of posting and publishing Public Notice Calling Public Hearing on the matter of amending Town Ordinance No. 25, Regulating Bingo. The affidavits were ordered filed.

PUBLIC HEARING - 10:45 A.M. continued:

Town Attorney William C. Haugaard stated that the amendment provides the penalty provision to the Town's Bingo Ordinance No. 25, to conform to the new Penal Law.

Supervisor Vojvoda thereupon asked if anyone wished to be heard on the amendment.

No one wishing to be heard and no communications having been received thereto, Supervisor Vojvoda declared the Hearing closed and re-opened the meeting.

Leo Saxstien, Attorney, representing Roanoke Lodge No. 462, dated January 3, 1969, requesting additional increase of \$125.00 per month for town hall rental of quarters, due to unreasonable increase of town taxes, district and county taxes and stating that the Trustees would be willing to meet with the Board to discuss the matter. Supervisor Vojvoda recessed the meeting to hold a public hearing.

PUBLIC HEARING - 11:00 A.M.

Town Clerk submitted affidavits of posting and publishing Public Notice Calling Public Hearing on the matter of amending Traffic Control and Parking Ordinance No. 3.

The affidavits were ordered filed.

Town Attorney William C. Haugaard stated that the amendments were being proposed pursuant to agreement with the Department of Transportation in connection with the Long Island Expressway.

Supervisor Vojvoda thereupon asked if anyone wished to be heard on the amendments.

No one wishing to be heard and no communications having been received thereto, Supervisor Vojvoda declared the Hearing closed and re-opened the meeting.

RESOLUTIONS

BE IT RESOLVED, That William C. Haugaard, Town Attorney, be compensated at the rate of \$11,500 per annum, payable bi-weekly, effective January 1, 1969.

Those having a tenure of ten (10) years as of January 1, 1969, to be paid 4%.

Those having a tenure of fifteen (15) years as of January 1, 1969, to be paid 5%.

Those having a tenure of twenty (20) years as of January 1, 1969, to be paid 6%.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Town Justice Costello.

WHEREAS, Under Section 64 of the Town Law, it is provided that the Town Board shall designate by written resolution the bank or trust companies in which certain town officers shall deposit the moneys coming into their hands by virtue of their offices,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Suffolk County National Bank, Franklin National Bank and Security National Bank, all of Riverhead, New York, and the North Fork Bank and Trust Company of Jamesport, New York, be and they are hereby designated as depositories in which the Supervisor, Town Clerk, Town Justices, Building Inspector, Recreation Department Supervisor and the Receiver of Taxes of this Town shall deposit all moneys coming into their hands by virtue of their offices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be entered in the minutes of the meeting of said Board.

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 64 (11) of the Town Law, the NEWS-REVIEW of Riverhead, New York, be and hereby is designated as the official newspaper for the publication of all notices, resolutions, ordinances and other matters required by law to be published for the Town of Riverhead for the year 1969.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Town Justice Zaloga.

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Supervisor be authorized to act in the capacity of Welfare Officer of the Town of Riverhead, at no additional compensation, and be it further

RESOLVED, That Sophie V. Waski be and is hereby appointed to act in the capacity of Deputy Welfare Officer of the Town of Riverhead, at no additional compensation.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, ^{Not} Voting. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED, 1. That all salaries of civil service employees of the Police Department be increased 8% over 1968, exclusive of longevity.

2. Longevity shall be 4% for 10 years and after; 5% for 15 years and after; and 6% for 20 years and after based on prior year's salary; as to any employee who starts in January of any year, longevity shall be computed from the first day of January of that year.

3. Hospitalization shall be paid at the rate of 50% for the employee only for the lowest possible plan of hospitalization.

4. Each officer shall submit a requisition of uniforms required to the Chief of Police in an annual maximum amount of \$150.00.

5. Vacations; After 1 year of employment all regular employees of the Department, 15 working days; after 10 years - 17 working days; and after 15 years - 20 working days.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

PERSONAL APPEARANCES:

Mr. Maurie Semel appeared before the Board and read a statement protesting the movement of sand on town property.

Mr. Semel stated that the sale of the sand is an illegal act and should be stopped and requested the Board to also put a stop to the using of a town employee and town equipment in the operation of the sand removal.

Mr. Semel's statement is filed in the office of the Town Clerk.

Supervisor Vojvoda advised Mr. Semel that there is a surplus of such sand and it was being moved to make room for garbage disposal.

After further discussion, it was decided that the matter be referred to the Town Attorney for further review.

Mr. Dick Manning stated that there may be an insurance problem involving town equipment being used in the operation of such sand removal.

Supervisor Vojvoda assured Mr. Manning that the town's liability policy covered such operation.

Mr. Arthur J. Fisher, Wading River, N. Y., appeared before the Board making protest on the method used to destroy dogs at the Riverhead Dog Pound. Mr. Fisher stated that the carbon monoxide method takes at least ten minutes to kill and roasts the dog before it is killed.

After discussion, Town Justice Costello assured Mr. Fisher that the Board would look into the matter.

HIGHWAY MATTERS

Alex E. Horton, Supt. of Highways made inquiry as to the status of easements on drainage projects.

DEPARTMENTAL HEADS

Police Chief Grodski informed the Board that the Police Department is experiencing difficulties in obtaining services of physicians regarding blood tests.

Chief Grodski advised the Board that there is a possibility of getting registered nurses to perform this work if a compensatory fee could be established by the Board.

Town Justice Costello suggested that the Chief explore the possibility of taking the prisoners to the hospital emergency room for the blood tests.


A discussion was held on the feasibility of a "breath-0-later" and it was decided that the matter would be taken under consideration.
