PERSONAL APPEARANCES continued:

Mr. William Herschler spoke at length regarding the request for Permit for Day Care Center - proposed location - Otto DeFriest's former homestead in Sound Avenue.

Mr. Herschler outlined that the Economic Opportunity Development of Patchogue is sponsoring the project, that the proposal will be limited to housing 30 children - all from the Riverhead area. Federal moneys will provide transportation, Welfare funds will provide day care maintenance - also moneys will be provided by parents who are able to pay tuition. Children will be from those parents who are working or disabled. The Calverton Unit will be relocated to the Sound Avenue area if the Permit is granted.

The Town Board reserved its decision pending further information.

HIGHWAY MATTERS

Alex E. Horton, Supt. of Highways informed the Board that the Hubbard Avenue Project is being completed.

Also advised that the sump at Little Bay, Wading River is in need of correction.

Also advised that the request of Mr. Pasquale to remove locust tree cannot be granted as the tree is not on Mr. Pasquale's property.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT

Building Inspector Edward R. Munson reported that the Long Island Lighting Company has cleaned up the Junk Yard at Wading River and is presently working on correcting the situation on the West Main Street area.

RESOLUTIONS

## (Recital)

WHEREAS, The Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, has heretofore duly authorized, sold and issued its \$41,500 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE for construction of roads in the Northville Homes Road Improvement District, pursuant to the resolution duly adopted by the Town Board on August 20, 1969, and it is now necessary to redeem said Note to the extent of \$2,500, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The \$41,500 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE-1969 for the construction of roads in the Northville Homes Road Improvement District is hereby authorized to be redeemed on September 8, 1970, to the extent of \$2,500 from funds of said Town, now available to said purpose, and the said amount of \$2,500 is hereby appropriated therefor.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

The adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Town Justice Costello, and duly put to a vote on roll call, which resulted as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL IN PART OF A \$41,500 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS IN THE NORTHVILLE HOMES ROAD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW NOTE IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$39,000.

## (Recital)

WHEREAS, The Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, has heretofore duly authorized, sold and issued its \$41,500 Bond Anticipation Note in connection with the construction of roads in the Northville Homes Improvement District, and it is now necessary and desirable to provide for the renewal in part, of said Note by the issuance of a new Note in the principal amount of \$39,000; now, therefore, be it

## RESOLUTION continued:

RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The \$41,500 Bond Anticipation Note-1969 for construction of Roads in the Northville Homes Road Improvement District of the Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, dated September 8th, 1969, maturing September 8, 1970, numbered 1-RRR, heretofore duly authorized sold and issued pursuant to the Resolution duly adopted by the Town Board on August 19, 1969, is hereby authorized to be renewed, in part, by the issuance of a new Note in the principal amount of \$39,000, said Note dated September 8, 1969, having been heretofore authorized to be redeemed to the extent of \$2,500, all as hereinabove referred to in the Recital hereof, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law of the State of New York. The maturity of said renewal Note herein authorized shall not be later than one year from its date.

Section 2. The terms, form and details of said renewal Note shall be as follows:

Form of Note:	Substantially in accordance with the form as prescribed by Law.

Section 3. Said Note is hereby sold to \_\_\_\_\_ at the price of par, to bear interest at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_ % per annum, payable at maturity, and the Supervisor is hereby authorized to deliver said Note to said purchaser upon receipt of the principal amount, plus accrued interest, if any, from the date of said Note to the date of delivery.

Section 4. Said Note shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by Section 52.00 of said Local Finance Law, and shall be a general obligation of the Town, payable as to both principal and interest by a general tax upon all the taxable real property within the Town, without limitation of rate or amount. The faith and credit of the Town are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said Note and provision shall be made in the budget of the Town by appropriation for the redemption of the Note to mature in such year and for the payment of interest to be due in such year.

RESOLUTION continued:

Section 5. Said Note shall be executed in the name of the Town by its Supervisor and the corporate seal of said Town shall be affixed thereto and attested by its Town Clerk.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

WHEREAS, the following applications for the construction of curbs and gutters have been received by the Town Board and reviewed by the Highway Committee, which recommends that curbs and gutters be constructed at a cost to the applicant for materials and an expense not exceeding a sum to the Town as listed hereinafter:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the execution of the contract the Superintendent of Highways be directed to perform the work.

WHEREAS the aforementioned COSIMO SAGLIOCCA, MARCO SAGLIOCCA, ANTHONY SAGLIOCCA, and MARYANNE CANNILLA, the principals, and REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY, the surety, wish to extend the bond from December 7, 1969 to December 7, 1971, and

WHEREAS they have duly made petition to the Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead, and

WHEREAS the Planning Board has consented to the extension of the bonds on the condition that it be increased to \$165,000.00 to December 7, 1971, and

WHEREAS the above COSIMO SAGLIOCCA, MARCO SAGLIOCCA, ANTHONY SAGLIOCCA, and MARYANNE CANNILIA, the principals, and REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY, the surety, have duly filed a bond in the amount of \$165,000.00 to and from December 7, 1969 to December 7, 1971,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the above bond of COSIMO SAGLIOCCA, MARCO SAGLIOCCA, ANTHONY SAGLIOCCA, and MARYANNE CANNILLA, the principals, and REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY, the surety, is hereby accepted in the amount of \$165,000.00 from December 7, 1969 to December 7, 1971, and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the bond dated December 7, 1967 in the amount of \$150,000.00 is hereby released to the above COSIMO SAGLIOCCA, MARCO SAGLIOCCA, ANTHONY SAGLIOCCA and MARYANNE CANNILLA, the principals, and REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY, the surety.

Councilman Grodski offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

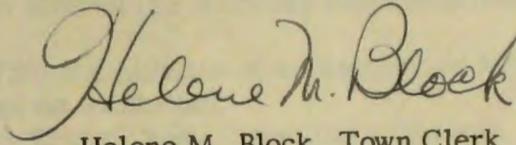
