3. To change from existing Farm I Use District to Business I Use District all that certain property situate at Calverton, Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk and State of New York, bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at a monument set at the corner formed by the intersection of the north side of State Highway (Route 25) and the east side of Timber Drive, as shown on Map of Timber Park, Section 1, filed in the Suffolk County Clerk's Office on March 17, 1948 as Map No. 1615; running thence North 7 degrees 01' East along the east side of Timber Drive 231.27 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 7 as shown on said map; thence South 82 degrees 59' East along Lot 7, as shown on said Map, 100 feet; thence South 7 degrees 00' West along land of Edward Jermusyk, 241.10 feet to the north side of State Highway (Route 25); running thence North 77 degrees 22' West along the northerly side of State Highway (Route 25) 100.48 feet to the point or place of beginning.
