

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, March 2, 1965 at 10:30 A. M.

Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Zaloga.

RESOLVED, That the minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held in the Town Hall on February 16, 1965, be approved as submitted.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Mrs. Hazel Brenner, appeared before the Board relative to the matter of the erection of a sign for the Motel located on the intersection of Peconic Bay Blvd. and Bay Ave., in Aquebogue.

Mrs. Brenner stated that her request for a Permit to erect such sign was denied by the Board of Appeals and that her appearance before the Town Board was for the purpose of requesting the Board's consideration in changing the Zoning Ordinance in the area of the Motel, from Residence 1 to Business Zone.

Mrs. Brenner further stated that the erection of the sign is vitally necessary for the Motel's business in order that people be able to locate the Motel.

The Board discussed the request as presented by Mrs. Brenner and referred the matter to Town Attorney Shepard M. Scheinberg with the stipulation that it be included with other Zoning Change Petitions to be taken under consideration at the next meeting of the Planning Board.

Mr. Joseph Brandt appeared before the Board and suggested that it take under consideration the construction of a skating rink on Fishel Avenue to be maintained by the Town. Mr. Brandt stated that while he realizes the initial cost would be great he believes that in time to come the rink would be self-sustaining.

The matter was referred to Kenneth G. Rowland, Recreation Superintendent.

Police Chief Grodski appeared before the Board and requested permission to house the Parking Meter Scooter and unclaimed bicycles in the Town Garage to be located on the Roanoke Avenue Parking Field.

The matter was tabled for further study by the Board.

The Tax Receiver's Report dated March 1, 1965 was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

The Police Department Report for the month of February, 1965 was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

The Building Inspector's Report for the month of February, 1965 was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

The Recreation Department Report for the month of February, 1965 was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

The Jamesport Fire District Treasurer's Report for the year 1964 was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

The Wading River Fire District Treasurer's Report for the year 1964 was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

The Wading River Fire District's Election results on proposition to construct addition to Fire House was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

A communication from Pauline Linden under date of February 15, 1965, protesting the prospect of zoning changes which would permit Sand and Gravel Operations in Wading River, was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

A communication from Curtis R. Fremond under date of February 10, 1965, protesting plans to turn areas in Wading River into gravel pits, was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

A copy of a communication from McCrosky-Reuter dated Feb. 19, 1965, addressed to the Planning Board advising that copies of the Survey and Master Plan Reports will be available for Town and Planning Board Officials at a meeting scheduled for March 8, 1965, was submitted to the Board and ordered filed.

A communication from George A. Goode, D.V.M., under date of Feb. 19, 1965 was submitted to the Board making request for "No Standing" or "No Parking" signs to be placed along the front of his property on West Main Street, Riverhead, N. Y.

The matter was referred to Police Chief Grodski.

A communication from the Office of the County Attorney of Suffolk County, dated Feb. 24, 1965, making request for survey of contemplated condemnations by the Town of Riverhead, was submitted to the Board.

The communication was ordered filed and the matter referred to the Town Attorney.

A communication from Lloyd P. Dodge dated Feb. 24, 1965, making request for Zoning Change in the area of Middle Road and Harrison Avenue, Riverhead, N. Y., was submitted to the Board.

The communication was ordered filed and the matter referred to the Town Attorney.

A communication under date of Feb. 10, 1965 from Joseph W. Brush, Partner of L. Leon Fanning d/b/a Fanning and Brush relative to windshield damage to Pickup Truck caused by Highway Department Sand and Gravel Truck was submitted to the Board.

The Town Clerk informed the Board that the matter was referred to the Town Insurance Broker.

The communication was ordered filed.

A communication from the State of New York Department of Public Works dated Feb. 24, 1965, was submitted to the Board giving notice that 1.5 miles of the Long Island Expressway will be constructed in the Town of Riverhead and advising that any recommendations and suggestions that the Board may have to offer on the design of said Expressway be submitted within 20 calendar days after the date of communication.

The communication was ordered filed.

A communication was submitted to the Board from Friends of St. Patrick, Inc., dated Feb. 6, 1965, extending invitation to march as a unit in the 15th Annual St. Patrick's Parade to be held on Sunday, March 14, 1965.

The communication was ordered filed and referred to the Town Attorney for reply.

A communication dated March 1, 1965 was submitted to the Board from Mr. and Mrs. Harry Brenner relative to a request for change of zoning in the area of Peconic Bay Blvd., and Bay Ave., Aquebogue, N. Y.

The communication was ordered filed and the matter referred to the Town Attorney.

The Town Board denied the request of Morton Zahler to install a Snack Bar at his Marina.

The Town Clerk was directed to advise Mr. Zahler as to the Board's decision.

Town Attorney Shepard M. Scheinberg advised the Board that it is necessary to make amendments to Excavation Ordinance No. 31.

The Board directed the Town Attorney to compile the necessary changes for its study.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Costello.

RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk be and hereby is directed and authorized to advertise in the March 4, 1965 issue of the News-Review, the official newspaper of the Town of Riverhead, for bids for the construction of fencing the recharge basin (Drainage Project #25) at Manor Lane, Jamesport, Town of Riverhead, New York, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk be and is hereby designated to open publicly and read aloud on Friday, March 12, 1965 at 10:00 A. M., in the Town Clerk's Office, 220 Roanoke Avenue, Riverhead, New York, all bids which have been received, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk shall make a record of such bids and present the same at the Town Board Meeting to be held on March 16, 1965.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

RESOLVED, That Highway bill submitted on Warrant dated March 2, 1965 as follows; Machinery Fund Item No. 3-Rand-MacMurray, Inc., dated Feb. 15, 1965 in the amount of \$608.82 be and is hereby approved.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Costello.

RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to advertise for sealed bids on Transit-Mix Concrete for use of the Town of Riverhead Highway Department, and be it

RESOLVED, That specifications be prepared by the Superintendent of Highways, and bids to be returnable up to 11:00 A. M., on March 15, 1965, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk be and hereby is designated to open publicly and read aloud on Monday, March 15, 1965 at 11:00 A. M., at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, 220 Roanoke Avenue, Riverhead, New York, all sealed bids bearing the designation "Bids on Transit-Mix".

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the Superintendent of Highways be and is hereby authorized to pay snow overtime compensation for the period from February 1, 1965 to February 15, 1965, for 291 hours in the sum of \$667.95.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga,

Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was there-upon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the Superintendent of Highways be and is hereby authorized to pay snow overtime compensation for February 22, 1965 for a total of 152 hours in the amount of \$394.90.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was there-upon declared duly adopted.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Costello.

RESOLVED, That members of the Town Board, Town Attorney Shepard M. Scheinberg, Water Plant Superintendent John P. Riesdorph, Alden W. Young, Engineer and Special Counsel Pierre G. Lundberg be and they are hereby authorized to attend meetings to be held with the New York State Atomic Energy Commission and Naval Department Officials in New York City on March 4, 1965, and that all necessary expenses in connection with said meetings be charged to the General Town Fund.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was there-upon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills submitted on Warrants dated March 2, 1965 as follows: General Town - \$7,973.04, General Repairs Highway Item No. 1 - \$68.42, Machinery Highway Item No. 3 - \$8,280.17, and Miscellaneous Highway Item No. 4 - \$7.75.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Costello.

RESOLVED, That the General Town bills as submitted in the amount of \$7,973.04 be approved for payment, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That General Repairs Highway Item No. 1 bills in the amount of \$68.42, Machinery Highway Item No. 3 bills in the amount of \$8,280.16, and Miscellaneous Highway Item No. 4 bills in the amount of \$7.75, be approved for payment.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was there-upon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned at 11:25 A. M., to meet on Tuesday, March 16, 1965 at 10:30 A. M.
