Lundberg be and they are hereby authorized to attend a meeting to be held with the New York State Atomic Energy Commission in New York City, New York, Friday, April 23, 1965, and that all necessary expenses in connection with said meeting be charged to the General Town Fund.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That General Repairs Highway Item No. 1 bills in the amount of \$3,006.88, Bridge Highway Item No. 2 bills in the amount of \$789.34, Machinery Highway Item No. 3 bills in the amount of \$8,750.90 and Miscellaneous Highway Item No. 4 bills in the amount of \$2,918.85, be approved for payment.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
