

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD HELD IN THE TOWN HALL ON TUESDAY, JUNE 4, 1963, AT 10 A.M.

AT 10:00 A. M. NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING WAS READ AND SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD RELATIVE TO THE ADOPTION OF "ORDINANCE No. 3, RIVERHEAD TOWN PARKING AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE."

SUPERVISOR LEONARD THEREUPON DECLARED THE HEARING OPEN TO ANYONE WISHING TO BE HEARD IN FAVOR OF OR IN OPPOSITION TO SAID PROPOSED ORDINANCE.

ATTORNEY EDWIN LAPHAM APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD IN BEHALF OF ANTON DIEBOLD, OAK STREET, WADING RIVER, AND IN BEHALF OF NEIGHBORS OF MR. DIEBOLD'S IN WADING RIVER IN FAVOR OF THE ADOPTION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

MR. LAPHAM STATED THAT THEY WERE PARTICULARLY IN FAVOR OF THE PARTS OF THE ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO THE LIMITATION OF NIGHT TIME PARKING AT THE TOWN PARKING SPACES AT THE BEACH AT WADING RIVER, AND THE LIMITATION ON PARKING WITHIN 500' OF THE WATER ON THE ROADS LEADING TO THE TOWN BEACHES.

FURTHER, THAT PEOPLE ALONG THE BEACH HAVE BEEN PLAGUED BY PEOPLE WHO DRIVE ALONG THE BEACH AT ALL HOURS OF THE NIGHT AND THAT HE WOULD BE IN FAVOR OF THE PROHIBITION OF SUCH DRIVING ALONG THE BEACH.

MR. FRANCIS E. HOWELL, REPRESENTING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE OF THE EAST END SURF FISHING CLUB, APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD.

HE STATED THAT THEY DID A LOT OF SURF FISHING AT NIGHT AND HE WONDERED IF THIS ORDINANCE WOULD PREVENT FISHERMEN FROM PARKING THEIR CARS AT THE BEACH AT NIGHT, AND IF SO, HE OBJECTED TO THESE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE.

FURTHER, THAT HE FELT THE TOWN ATTORNEY SHOULD FIND OUT WHO OWNS THE BEACH.

NO ONE ELSE WISHING TO BE HEARD SUPERVISOR LEONARD DECLARED THE HEARING CLOSED.

IT WAS THE CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD THAT SUB-DIVISION (H) OF SECTION 2 SHOULD BE DELETED FROM SAID ORDINANCE.

AFTER DISCUSSION CHIEF OF POLICE GRODSKI WAS DIRECTED TO HOLD A CONFERENCE WITH MR. HOWELL AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE EAST END SURF FISHING CLUB FOR A FURTHER STUDY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE

AND TO REPORT HIS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE TOWN BOARD.
NO FURTHER ACTION TAKEN BY THE BOARD IN THIS MATTER.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS ON MOTION AND VOTE, THE
MEETING ADJOURNED.
