

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD  
HELD IN THE TOWN HALL ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 1963 AT 10:30 A. M.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS  
SECONDED BY JUSTICE COSTELLO. D

RESOLVED THAT THE MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS OF THE TOWN BOARD HELD  
IN THE TOWN HALL ON OCTOBER 1, 1963 AND OCTOBER 8, 1963 BE APPROVED  
AS SUBMITTED.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE  
COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS  
THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

MR. ROBERT LEAF REPRESENTING THE MERCHANTS DIVISION OF THE RIVER-  
HEAD CHAMBER OF COMMERCE APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD AND REQUESTED  
THAT THE PARKING METERS BE COVERED DURING THE SHOPPING SEASON PRIOR  
TO CHRISTMAS AND THAT FREE PARKING BE ALLOWED. S

TOWN ATTORNEY SAXSTEIN STATED THAT THIS WOULD BE CONTRARY TO THE  
PARKING METER ORDINANCE AND WOULD BE ILLEGAL.

CHIEF OF POLICE GRODSKI VOICED HIS OBJECTIONS TO THIS REQUEST.

AFTER A LENGTHY DISCUSSION THE MATTER WAS REFERRED TO JUSTICE  
ZALOGA.

MR. AL SHIELDS, PROGRAM DIRECTOR, OF RADIO STATION WAPG APPEARED  
BEFORE THE BOARD AND ASKED PERMISSION TO WALK A LIVE TURKEY ON THE  
SIDEWALK ALONG MAIN STREET.

PERMISSION GRANTED BY THE BOARD.

ATTORNEY GORDON LIPETZ APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD RELATIVE TO AN  
EXCHANGE OF EASEMENTS AT "GREAT MEADOWS", JAMESPORT, TO ALLEVIATE A  
DRAINAGE PROBLEM ON TOWN HIGHWAYS AND ON A PRIVATE ROAD OF DOUGLAS  
STARK, ETAL.

IT WAS THE CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD THAT IT APPEARED THAT THE  
EXCHANGE WOULD BE EQUITABLE AND BENEFICIAL TO THE TOWN.

MATTER TABLED UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT MR. LIPETZ PREPARE NECESSARY  
DOCUMENTS FOR EASEMENTS.

MR. FRED HERBST, REPRESENTING CUSHMAN MOTOR WORKS, APPEARED  
BEFORE THE BOARD RELATIVE TO THE PURCHASE OF A NEW TRUCKSTER TO

REPLACE THE ONE NOW BEING USED BY THE METER MAN. AS THE AMOUNT TO BE EXPENDED EXCEEDS \$1000.00, IT WAS THE CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD THAT SAID PURCHASE BE ADVERTISED FOR PUBLIC BIDDING.

MATTER REFERRED TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

A COMMUNICATION DATED NOVEMBER 11, 1963 FROM JOHN L. HAFFORD WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

"RESPECTFULLY REQUEST PERMISSION BE GIVEN THE UNDERSIGNED TO SOLICIT, CONTRACT AND OPERATE LIGHT SNOW PLOWING EQUIPMENT ON THE RIVERHEAD SIDEWALKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MOVING SNOW TO THE CURB.

YOUR EARLY REPLY WILL BE MOST HELPFUL AND APPRECIATED IN THE PREPARATION FOR THE NEXT SNOW." END.

IT WAS THE CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD THAT IT HAD NO JURISDICTION IN THIS MATTER.

COMMUNICATION ORDERED FILED.

A COMMUNICATION DATED NOVEMBER 12, 1963 FROM THE JAMESPORT-SOUTH JAMESPORT CIVIC ASSOCIATION WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD REQUESTING A MEETING WITH THE TOWN BOARD RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPLANTING AND RE-SEEDING OF OYSTERS AND SCALLOPS IN THE JAMESPORT AREA.

THE TOWN CLERK WAS DIRECTED TO REPLY THAT SAID MEETING WILL BE HELD ON DECEMBER 3, 1963 AT 2:00 P. M.

COMMUNICATION ORDERED FILED.

APPLICATIONS FOR CURBS AND GUTTERS WERE SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD FROM JOHN A. ROLLE AND SYLVESTER HERMAN.

MATTER REFERRED TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.

A LETTER OF RESIGNATION WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD FROM PATROLMAN ROBERT A. TIEDEMAN EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 30, 1963.

LETTER ORDERED FILED.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE ZALOGA.

RESOLVED THAT THE RESIGNATION OF ROBERT A. TIEDEMAN, POLICE PATROLMAN (PROBATIONARY) BE ACCEPTED, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 30, 1963.

THE VOTE--COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE ZALOGA.

RESOLVED THAT THE POLICE CHIEF BE AND HE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO CANVASS THE CURRENT POLICE PATROLMAN'S LIST OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF A SUBSTITUTE APPOINTMENT, FILLING THE VACANCY CREATED BY JOSEPH GRATTAN'S MILITARY LEAVE OF ABSENCE AND THE VACANCY CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF ROBERT A. TIEDEMAN.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

AT 12:15 P. M. SUPERVISOR LEONARD CALLED A RECESS FOR LUNCH, THE BOARD TO RECONVENE AT 3:30 P. M.

AT 3:30 P. M. THE BOARD RECONVENED WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR LEONARD.

RESOLVED THAT MARGUERITE FLEISCHMAN AND DOROTHY JERMUSYK BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY APPOINTED PART-TIME CLERKS IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECEIVER OF TAXES EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 25, 1963; MARGUERITE FLEISCHMAN TO BE COMPENSATED AT THE RATE OF \$12.00 PER DAY; DOROTHY JERMUSYK TO BE COMPENSATED AT THE RATE OF \$10.00 PER DAY, BOTH PAYABLE SEMI-MONTHLY AND TO SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE TOWN BOARD.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE COSTELLO.

RESOLVED THAT A PUBLIC HEARING BE HELD ON DECEMBER 3, 1963 AT 11:00 A. M. RELATIVE TO THE RENEWAL OF THE AQUEBOGUE, ROANOKE AND CALVERTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT CONTRACTS.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

THE TOWN BOARD CONVENED AS A BOARD OF AUDIT AND EXAMINED ALL TOWN BILLS TO DATE, THE TOTAL OF WHICH WAS AS FOLLOWS: GENERAL TOWN---\$3,108.10.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE ZALOGA.

RESOLVED THAT THE GENERAL TOWN BILLS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,108.10 BE APPROVED AND PAID AS RENDERED.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS ON MOTION AND VOTE, THE MEETING ADJOURNED AT 4:30 P. M. TO MEET ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 3RD, 1963 AT 10:30 A. M.
