

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD HELD IN THE TOWN HALL ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 1962 AT 9:00 A. M.

A LETTER OF RESIGNATION DATED NOVEMBER 27, 1962 FROM CHARLES A. HORTON, RECEIVER OF TAXES WAS READ TO THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

"PLEASE ACCEPT MY RESIGNATION, AS RECEIVER OF TAXES OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY." END.

LETTER ORDERED FILED.

COUNCILMAN STOTZKY OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BELL.

WHEREAS, A VACANCY EXISTS IN THE OFFICE OF RECEIVER OF TAXES, IN THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, DUE TO THE RESIGNATION OF CHARLES ALLEN HORTON ON NOVEMBER 27, 1962, WHO WAS ELECTED TO SUCH OFFICE ON THE 7TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1961, FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF SECTION 64 OF THE TOWN LAW, OLIN P. TUTHILL OF SOUND AVENUE, RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, BE AND HE HEREBY IS APPOINTED TO FILL THE VACANCY EXISTING IN SUCH OFFICE OF RECEIVER OF TAXES, SUCH APPOINTMENT TO BE EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 1962 AND DATE OF HIS QUALIFICATION, AND THE SAID OLIN P. TUTHILL TO HOLD SUCH OFFICE UNTIL NOVEMBER 6, 1963 AND UNTIL QUALIFICATION OF HIS SUCCESSOR;

TO BE COMPENSATED AT THE RATE OF \$4000.00 PER ANNUM PAYABLE MONTHLY,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT SAID OLIN P. TUTHILL QUALIFY BY THE FILING OF AN OFFICIAL UNDERTAKING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, COUNCILMAN STOTZKY, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

A SURVEY DATED NOVEMBER 27, 1962 FROM THE LONG ISLAND LIGHTING COMPANY WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD RELATIVE TO IMPROVED STREET

LIGHTING ON ROANOKE AVENUE, NORTH OF ROUTE 58 IN FRONT OF THE CENTRAL SUFFOLK HOSPITAL.

A COMMUNICATION DATED NOVEMBER 28, 1962 FROM THE CENTRAL SUFFOLK HOSPITAL WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD RECOMMENDING THE INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTING AS PER SAID SURVEY.


SURVEY AND COMMUNICATION ORDERED FILED.

COUNCILMAN BELL OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN STOTZKY.

RESOLVED THAT THE LONG ISLAND LIGHTING COMPANY BE AND IT IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO INSTALL IMPROVED STREET LIGHTING ON ROANOKE AVENUE, NORTH OF OLD COUNTRY ROAD, RIVERHEAD LIGHT DISTRICT, AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE CENTRAL SUFFOLK HOSPITAL, AS PER SURVEY AND SKETCH DATED NOVEMBER 27, 1962 AND FILED WITH THE TOWN CLERK ON NOVEMBER 29, 1962.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, COUNCILMAN STOTZKY, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS ON MOTION AND VOTE, THE MEETING ADJOURNED.
