
WAIVER OF NOTICE ORDERED FILED.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE ZALOGA.

RESOLVED THAT LAWRENCE MAZZO, ROBERT QUINN AND DONALD J. ROBINSON BE APPOINTED AS POLICE PATROLMEN IN THE RIVERHEAD TOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT; THAT THEIR COMPENSATION IS FIXED AT \$3800.00 PER ANNUM, PAYABLE SEMI-MONTHLY; THAT THEIR APPOINTMENT IS FOR A PROBATIONARY TERM PURSUANT TO SUFFOLK COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE RULES; AND THAT THEIR APPOINTMENT SHALL BE EFFECTIVE THE 1ST DAY OF JULY, 1961.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, COUNCILMAN STOTZKY, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.
