

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, September 9, 1958 at 10:30 A. M.

Bids ordered filed.

Councilman Benedict offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Stotzky.

RESOLVED that the bid for 100,000 or more of road oil for use by the Town Highway Department be and it is hereby awarded to Welch Asphalt Company, Riverhead, N.Y., as per their bid and specification form submitted, dated September 8, 1958.

The Vote---Councilman Stotzky, Yes; Councilman Benedict, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent; Justice Zaloga, Absent; and Supervisor Leonard, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A letter dated September 8, 1958 from Henry M. Zaleski was read to the Board as follows:

"Please be advised that I am the attorney for Wildwood Acres Association, Inc. of Wildwood, N.Y. The association is formulating plans for the dedication of certain roads in the Wildwood Acres area to the Town of Riverhead. The roads that are to be dedicated include the following: Park Street; Hulse Avenue; Hill Street; and Wildwood Road, north of Hill Street. Please advise whether or not the Board would be receptive to this dedication if the regulations pertaining to dedication of roads to the Town are complied with. In connection with the proposed dedication as above outlined, it is the intention of the Wildwood Acres Association to request the Town Board to create a special highway improvement district after the dedication of the roads. The exact area to be included in the said improvement district will be outlined in detail to the Planning Board when and if you refer this matter to the Planning Board. The streets to be dedicated, as outlined above, constitute approximately one mile of presently existing roads that are being used by most of the residents of the Wildwood Acres area. It is my understanding that the roads will have to be improved at considerable cost in order to put them into proper condition for dedication to the Town.

Any other or additional information that is required by you in connection with this matter will be gladly furnished you on request." End.

Letter ordered filed and matter referred to the Planning Board.

Councilman Benedict offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Stotzky.

RESOLVED that the next meeting of the Town Board be held on the usual meeting date, September 16, 1958 at 9:30 A.M.
