

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, September 20, 1955 at 10:00 A.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 6, 1955, were submitted and altered and on motion made by Justice Pike and seconded by Justice Warner, it was Resolved that the minutes be adopted as altered. The Vote---Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A letter dated September 8th, 1955, was read to the Board from Mr. Francis T. Conka of Calverton, New York. Mr. Conka objected strongly about the tenants of woodcliff Park in Calverton, stating that many of these tenants were creating a public nuisance and damaging Mr. Conka's property which adjoins the property of Ben Karlin, owner of Woodcliff Park. After discussion, the matter was referred to the Chief of Police.

A petition was read to the Board dated September 19, 1955, signed by thirteen residents living in the area of Riverhead Metals Company, Inc. on Lincoln Street in Riverhead, N.Y. These residents objected to the continuance of this business operation which they classify as a junk yard. After discussion, the Town Clerk was instructed to notify the petitioners that they have the right to appear before any Justice of the Peace and sign a complaint against the enterprise operating such business. The petition was ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's Report for the month of August 1955 was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read to the Board from the Long Island Lighting Company advising that on July 14th, twenty-nine (29) 100 c.p. aerial street lights were placed in operation, as indicated on enclosed sketch, in the Riverhead Lighting District along Riverside Drive. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read to the Board from Harry B. Ward, District Superintendent of Schools, acknowledging appointment of Curtis Young, as Attendance Supervisor for school district Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11 for the Town of Riverhead for year 1955-56 and approving same according to the provisions of Section 3213 of the New York Education Law. Communication was ordered placed on file.

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On motion made by Justice Pike and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was Resolved that Perry Weisen, Riverhead, N.Y. be appointed School Traffic Officer at the Calverton School, effective as of September 12, 1955, at the rate of \$1.75 per hour, payable semi-monthly. The Vote---Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Leonard made the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Warner:

RESOLVED that a public hearing be held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 5, 1955, at 10:30 A.M. in regard to fire protection for the Riverhead Fire Protection Districts, namely Aquebogue, Calverton and Roanoke, for the year 1956. The Vote---Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to sign contract with the Long Island Lighting Company to install electricity at the Riverhead Town Dump on Youngs Avenue to provide water service and, to employ an electrician to perform the other necessary electrical work required. The Vote---Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Clerk was instructed to write to the Long Island Lighting Company authorizing the Long Island Lighting Company to proceed with the installation of street lighting in Hart's Development in Wading River, as per survey dated 9-13-55.

The Town Clerk was further instructed to authorize the Long Island Lighting Company to install street lights on St. Mary's Drive in the Jamesport Lighting District.

On motion made by Justice Pike and seconded by Justice Leonard it was RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead meet on Wednesday, October 5, 1955 at 10:00 A.M. instead of Tuesday, October 4, 1955. The Vote---Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town Bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund---\$780.89 and Highway Machinery Fund---\$1111.97. On motion and vote it was Resolved that the bills be approved as rendered.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, October 5, 1955 at 10:00 A.M.
