

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, June 1, 1954 at 10:00 A.M.

Henry M. Zaleski, Town Attorney, Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways, Stephen J. Grodski, Police Chief, Alden W. Young, Supt. of Sewers, John Riesdorff, Asst. Supt. to Water District and Roselle Benjamin, Water Plant Superintendent, were also present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on May 18, 1954, were read and on motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the minutes be adopted as read. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Charles Allen Horton, Receiver of Taxes of the Town of Riverhead, submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of June 1, 1954, and the report was ordered placed on file.

The Police Report for the month of May, 1954, was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read to the Board from Joseph P. Celko, Aquebogue, N.Y. relative to the dedication of roads as public highways of the Town of Riverhead located in Aquebogue, N.Y. as per enclosed plans. The matter was referred to the Riverhead Town Planning Board.

A communication was read from the Association of Towns advising that a Statewide School for Town Clerks will be held at Cornell University, Ithaca, N.Y. on June 21, 22 and 23rd, 1954. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that Anthony F. Gadzinski, Town Clerk, be authorized to attend the Statewide School for Town Clerks to be held at Cornell University on June 21, 22 and 23, 1954, and that all necessary expenses be paid. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that Myron C. Young, Superintendent of Highways, be authorized to attend the School for Superintendent of Highways at Cornell University on June 22, 23 and 24, 1954, and that all necessary expenses be paid. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The above bids were both rejected and ordered placed on file.

The bids on the purchase of oil for the Highway Department which were submitted to the Board on May 18, 1954, were again considered and the Board rejected all bids. The matter was referred to the Superintendent of Highways, calling a meeting of the Board on June 8, 1954 at 11:00 A.M. to accept new bids.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik, it was Resolved that the Superintendent of Highways, be authorized to purchase 4 (four) tanks for storing oil products at a price of \$800.00 from Albert P. Warner. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that Henry M. Zaleski, Town Attorney, be authorized to prepare papers for the abandonment of the road located at the North end of Pier Avenue, Riverhead, and at the North end of Sound Avenue and Creek Road in Wading River. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town Bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund---\$20,860.13 and Highway Machinery Fund---\$271.61.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, June 15, 1954 at 10:00 A.M.
