

Minutes of a special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, June 8, 1954 at 11:00 A.M.

Bids on the purchase of 200,000 gals of MC-1, MC-2, and RC-2 oil for the Highway Department were opened as follows:

The above bids were ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Pike it was Resolved that the bid of The Shell Oil Company, Sewaren, New Jersey, be accepted for the MC-1, MC-2, and RC-2 road oil, amount, (200,000 gallons), at a cost of .1082 per gallon for the year 1954 pursuant to the specifications outlined by Myron C. Young, Superintendent of Highways. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
