

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, July 6, 1954 at 10:00 A.M.

Myron C. Young, Superintendent of Highways, Stephen J. Grodski, Police Chief, Alden W. Young, Supt. of Sewers, John Riesdorff, Asst. Supt. to Water District and Roselle Benjamin, Water Plant Superintendent, were also present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on June 15, 1954, were read and on motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was Resolved that the minutes be adopted as read. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent.

Mr. James Chadwick, representing the Anko Properties addressed the Board in regard to the dedication of certain highways in the "Riverhead GreenS" Development, East Main Street, Riverhead, New York. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee, the Superintendent of Highways and Alden W. Young, Surveyor.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the following be appointed lifeguards at the Riverhead Town Beaches for the 1954 season, retroactive as of June 25, 1954, salaries fixed at \$45.00 per week, duties and hours to be determined by Justice Pike, Chairman of the Parks and Beach Committee:

The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted. Notice was Given to the Town Board that Daniel Carbonaro declined his appointment as lifeguard, as of June 15, 1954. A formal abandonment of the road end at Pier Avenue was submitted to the Board and filed by Amy L. Tooker and formal abandonment of the road end at Sound Avenue, Wading River, was submitted by Frank W. Phillips and Marie L. Phillips and ordered placed on file.

The bids were ordered placed on file and on motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the bid of Larry Berk, Riverhead, N.Y. for \$280.00, being the highest bid, for the Riverhead Town Police Motorcycle be accepted. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Police Report for the month of June 1954 was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the request of the Grace Episcopal Church to hold a circus on the Fair Grounds on August 14, 1954, be granted, subject to the rules and regulations governing the use of Town controlled property for bazaars, carnivals and circuses. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Mr. J. Laurino and Mr. Herbert Kay, owners of the Calverton Motel appeared before the Board and requested that the Board issue them special beach permits for the boarders at their Motel. After discussion, the Board denied the request.

Justice Warner made the following motion which was seconded by Justice Leonard:

Upon reading and filing the dedication and release of Mildred K. Patrick and others, dated July 2, 1954, and duly acknowledged, dedicating and releasing the necessary lands for a certain proposed town highway to be known as "St. Mary's Drive" be it

RESOLVED, that consent be and the same hereby is given that the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead, make an order laying out the aforesaid Town Highway to consist of the lands described in the said dedication and release and to extend as delineated upon the map annexed to said application, all in accordance with the provisions of Section 171 of the Highway Law of the State of New York.

The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Warner made the following motion which was

seconded by Justice Leonard:

Upon reading and filing the dedication and release of Siegfried Peters and others, dated May 18, 1954, and duly acknowledged, dedicating and releasing the necessary lands for a certain proposed town highway to be known as "Peters Drive" be it

RESOLVED, that consent be and the same hereby is given that the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead, make an order laying out the aforesaid Town Highway to consist of the lands described in the said dedication and release and to extend as delineated upon the map annexed to said application, all in accordance with the provisions of Section 171 of the Highway Law of the State of New York.

The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that Stephen J. Grodski, Chief of Police, be authorized to attend the annual Chiefs of Police Convention in New York City on July 26, 27, 28, and 29, 1954, and that all necessary expenses be paid. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes; Justice Pike, Absent. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town Bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund---\$6,514.37 and Highway Machinery Fund---\$823.65.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, July 20, 1954 at 10:00 A.M.
