

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, July 20, 1954 at 10:00 A.M.

Henry M. Zaleski, Town Attorney, Stephen J. Grodski, Police Chief, Alden W. Young, Supt. of Sewers, John Riesdorff, Asst. Supt to Water District and Roselle Benjmain, Water Plant Superintendent, were also present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on July 6, 1954, were read and on motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the minutes be adopted as read. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Supervisor's Report for the month of June 1954 was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the New York State Traffic Commission acknowledging receipt of our resolution pertaining to the traffic conditions in the vicinity of the traffic circle at the intersection of Route 58 and Roanoke Avenue, and advising that their field representative will make a study of said conditions. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the Town of Riverhead Planning Board relative to the acceptance of proposed highways through the property of Joseph P. Celic at Aquebogue, New York, as public highways, and the communication was ordered placed on file.

Justice Pike offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Yousik:

WHEREAS, by resolution made and adopted on July 19, 1954, The Town of Riverhead ^{Planning Board} recommended the acceptance by the Town of Riverhead as public highways, certain proposed highways through the property of Joseph P. Celic, Aquebogue, N.Y. in the Town of Riverhead,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the recommendation of the Riverhead Town Planning Board regarding these proposed public highways be accepted, and that said public highways be accepted by and dedicated to the Town of Riverhead at such time when the requirements as to the value of the adjacent property have been met and when the roads have been constructed all in accordance with the rules and regulations for the acceptance of highways within the Town of Riverhead. The Vote, Justices, Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read to the Board from Michael T. Valentino, Secretary of the Ock-A-Bock Community Association, Aquebogue, New York, relative to the motor boat races in the vicinity of "Dreamer's Cove" at Aquebogue, N.Y. A petition was attached signed by seventeen summer residents in that area protesting to the disturbances caused by the motor boat races. The communication was ordered placed on file and the matter referred to the Town Attorney.

A petition signed by thirteen residents of Riverside Drive, Riverhead, N.Y. was submitted to the board requesting that signs be placed on Riverside Drive to slow down fast drivers. The petition was ordered placed on file and the Suptl of Highways was instructed to place signs on Riverside Drive.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Pike it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to negotiate with Mrs. Ida Young for the purchase of her interests in the Peconic Bay Bathing Beach for the sum of \$200.00. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the term of Mrs. Louise Downs, as clerk to the Assessors, terminate as of July 7, 1954. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Pike and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved, that Harold Neems, Wading River, N.Y. be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Supervisor for School Districts Nos. 1,2,3,4,12 and 13 in the Town of Riverhead for the year 1954-55, and further

Resolved, that Caroline J. Densieski, Jamesport, N.Y. be and she hereby is appointed Attendance Supervisor for School Districts Nos. 8,9,10 and 11 in the Town of Riverhead for the year 1954-55, and be it further

Resolved, that their compensation be fixed at the rate of \$350.00 per school year, payable in ten monthly payments commencing on September 1954, which compensation shall include all expenses other than those incurred when attending meetings outside of the Town of Riverhead, called by the District Superintendent of Schools, at which time actual expenses are to be paid. The Vote, Justices Leonard, Pike, Warner and Yousik, Yes; Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A report was submitted to the Board from the Suffolk County Department of Health on the so-called "Bottoms" and the matter was ordered placed on the calendar for August 17, 1954, for further study and discussion.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund---\$8,276.43 and Highway Machinery Fund---\$900.96.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, August 3, 1954 at 10:00 A.M.
