

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 3, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 19, 1952 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the New York State Public Service Commission advising the Board that a hearing in regard to additional protection at the grade crossings of the Long Island Rail Road Company and Sweezy, Maple, Union and Ostrander Avenues in the Town of Riverhead will be held at the office of this Commission, Eighth Floor, 233 Broadway, New York, N.Y., on Friday, May 2, 1952, at 10:30 A.M. Daylight Saving Time. The matter was referred to the Town Attorney.

A suggested resolution was read from the Town of Riverhead Planning Board in regard to accepting Cranberry Street and Griffin Path as Town Highways, provided that the necessary land can be obtained. The matter was ordered placed on the calendar for the next Town Board meeting.

The Police Report for the Month of March 1952 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of April 1, 1952 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$8050.67, Highway Machinery Fund-\$788.24

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourn to meet on Wednesday, April 16, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.
