

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, June 4, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on May 31, 1952 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Proof of Publication of the public notice that the Town Board will consider the purchase of a tractor with bucket loader for the Highway Depart at a maximum estimated cost of \$14000.00 was read and ordered placed on file.

Bids for the purchase of a tractor with bucket loader were opened from Edward Ehrbar, Inc. and H.O. Penn Machinery Co. Inc.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to purchase one new Caterpillar D-4 Tractor from the H.O.Penn Machinery Co. Inc. for the sum of \$10,434.00 and the used Model T-4 Traxcavator as per bid submitted June 4, 1952. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A contract for street lighting in the South Jamesport Lighting District for a period of five years was submitted and executed by the Board.

A communication was read from Friese and Wazlo proposing to dedicate two roads to the Town of Riverhead if approved by the Town Board. The matter was referred to the Planning Board.

The Police report for the month of May, 1952 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Bids for Police uniforms were opened from A.F.Vojvoda and Perkins & Co. and on motion and vote were referred to the Police Committee and the Chief of Police with power to act.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town Bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$1822.94, Highway Machinery Fund-\$528.62.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 18, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.
