

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 4, 1950 at 2: 00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 28, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

The Town Clerk advised that all Oaths of Office and Undertakings required by Law were received and filed in the Office of the County Clerk of Suffolk County.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that William J. Hattrick be and he hereby is appointed Town Attorney of the Town of Riverhead to serve for a period of two years, salary fixed at the rate of \$2,100.00 per annum. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Attorney Hattrick was sworn in by Justice Gatz and was thereupon declared duly qualified as Town Attorney.

Supervisor Kelly appointed the following committees:

The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the meetings of the Town Board be held on the first and third Wednesdays of each month at the hour of 2:00 P.M. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Riverhead News be designated the official newspaper of the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Suffolk County Trust Company, Suffolk County National Bank and the Long Island State Bank and Trust Company be and they hereby are designated as depositories in which the Supervisor, Town Clerk and Receiver of Taxes of this Town shall deposit all moneys coming into their hands by virtue of their offices. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that Harry J. Kratoville be and he hereby is appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics of the Town of Riverhead for period of two years ending

ending December 31, 1951. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A petition signed by six taxpayers requesting the Board to adopt an Ordinance prohibiting the use of out-board motors on all lakes and ponds in the Town of Riverhead was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was referred to the Town Attorney.

A communication was read from Forrest Downs, Receiver of Taxes advising the Board that he has appointed Kathleen Cantlon as a part time Clerk in his office and asked the Board to confirm the appointment and fix her salary. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the appointment of Kathleen Cantlon as part time Clerk to the Receiver of Taxes is hereby confirmed, to serve at the discretion of the Receiver of Taxes at a salary of \$6.00 per day. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Association of Towns of the State of New York giving notice that the Annual Meeting will be held at the Commodore Hotel, New York City, beginning at 11:00 A.M., Monday February 6th, and ending at noon on Wednesday, February 8th, 1950. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor, Justices of the Peace, Town Attorney, Supt. of Highways, Town Clerk, Assessors, Clerk to the Assessors, members of the Town Planning Board and the consultant to the Town Planning Board be authorized to attend the annual meeting of the Association of Towns of the State of New York to be held at the Hotel Commodore, New York, N.Y. from February 6 to 8, 1950 and that all necessary expenses be paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Joseph V. Kelly, Supervisor be designated the Official Representative and Justice Austin H. Warner be designated the Alternate Representative to the Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns of the State of New York. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Report for the month of December 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of January 3, 1950 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from A. John Doscinski, Chief of Police requesting the Board to grant him a temporary leave of absence for a period of one year, effective February 1, 1950. The matter was referred to the Town Attorney to report at the next meeting.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it

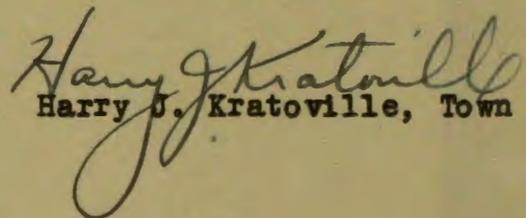
was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Michael Art Bronze Company the sum of \$483.95, said sum being one half of the gross receipts durin the month of December, 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the contract between the Harder Exterminating Company and the Town of Riverhead for the extermination of rats at the Town Dump be renewed for a period of one year for the sum of \$600.00, payable monthly. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Mr. Joseph J. Kozofsky and Mr. Louis Dormand addressed the Board wishing the official family much success during their terms of office.

The Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund - \$894.51 and Highway Macinery Fund - \$3015.00.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, January 18, 1950 at 3:00 P.M.
