

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall On Wednesday, March 1, 1950 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on February 15, 1950 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead purchase a parcel of land from Russell D. Koehler, west of the Branigan property on the North Wading River Road for the sum not to exceed \$200.00 for the purpose of straightening a hazardous curve on the said road. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes, submitted a report of the amount of Taxes collected as of March 1, 1950 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police Report for the month of February, 1950 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

An application was received from Henry W. Adelwerth and Vitus Adelwerth, as co-partners doing business under the firm name of the Blue Line for permission to operate a motor bus line in the Town of Riverhead from the intersection of Peconic Avenue and Main Street, thence westerly along Route #25 through Upper Mills and Calverton to the boundary line on Route #25 between the Townships of Riverhead and Brookhaven.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the above application be placed on file and that the Town Board hold a public hearing upon the said matter on April 5, 1950 at 2:00 P.M. and that the Town Clerk publish notice to that effect. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$1066.56, Highway Machinery Fund-\$984.81.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 15, 1950 at 2:00 P.M.
