

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, November 1, 1950 at 2:00 P.M.

William J. Hattrick, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 18, 1950 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Mr. Rogers and Mr. Conway of the New York State Dept. of Public Works addressed the Board in regard to surface water draining from the State Highway Route 25 into private property on the south side of the street in the vicinity of Ostrander Avenue, stating that they could do nothing about it until the sidewalk is raised on the south side otherwise there is no way of draining the water off.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to build approximately 700 feet of sidewalk on the south side of East Main Street (State Highway Route #25) in the Town of Riverhead from a point about 600 feet east of Ostrander Avenue to a point about 100 feet west of Ostrander Ave. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that the Town of Riverhead request permission from the New York State Department of Public Works to build approximately 700 feet of sidewalk on the south side of East Main Street (State Highway Route 25) in the Town of Riverhead from a point about 600 feet east of Ostrander Avenue to a point about 100 feet west of Ostrander Avenue, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the State of New York and/or its agents, servants and employees shall not be liable for injuries to persons and/or property, not caused by the State of New York, its agents, servants or employees, which may occur during the repairing and/or building by the Riverhead Town Superintendent of Highways of the aforesaid sidewalk on the south side of East Main Street (State Highway Route 25) Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A deed of dedication from Dewey Lewin of certain highways off of North Wading River Road and a deed of dedication from Aleta C? Baillard of certain Highways off Riverside Drive and Corwell Avenue for the purpose of Town Highways.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it

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RESOLVED, that the deed of dedication of certain roads as shown on a map entitled "Property of Dewey Lewin at Wading River" be and the same are hereby accepted as Town Highways, subject to the approval and signing of the Order to lay out the said Highways by the Town Supt. of Highways. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved, that the deed of dedication of a strip of land of Aleta C. Baillard fifty feet wide running from Corwell Avenue and thence at right angle to Riverside Drive as shown on a map thereof be and the same is hereby accepted as Town Highways, subject to the approval and signing of the Order to lay out the said Highways by the Town Supt. of Highways. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's report for the month of October, 1950 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.


The Police report for the month of October, 1950 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved, that the Lion's Club of Riverhead, N.Y. is hereby given permission to decorate the highways of the Town for the Holiday Season. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved, that the Bond of Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes of the Town of Riverhead be fixed at \$25,000.00 for the next fiscal year. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the totals of which are as follows: General Town Fund-\$3,194.01, Highway Machinery Fund-\$434.59.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 15, 1950 at 2:00 P.M.
