Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 5, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 29, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Joseph E. Walsh, Chief of the Riverhead Fire Department requesting the Board to allow the Fire Department to use the road running from West to East across the northerly portion of the old Fair Ground property, just north of the Town Highway building, for practice with the fire apparatus. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the request of the Riverhead Fire Department to use the the road just north of the Town Highway building on the old Fairground property for the purpose of practicing with the fire apparatus be granted. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's report for the month of December, 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Mico Art Bronze Co. the sum of \$679.58, said sum being one half of the gross receipts from the parking meters during the month of December, 1948 and pursuant to the agreement between the Mico Art Bronze Co. and the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Carl C. Young be and he hereby is appointed a member of the Riverhead Town Planning Board for a period of five years beginning on the 1st day of January, 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Report for the month of December 1948 and the Annual Police Report for 1948 were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to borrow the sum of \$3000.00 on a Tax Anticipation Note for a period of one year for the purpose of paying for a Snowgo for the Highway Department. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No. 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from the New York State Association of Towns stating that the annual meeting will be held in the City of New York on February 16-18, 1949 and urged all Officers to attend. The communication was ardered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor, Justices of the Peace, Town Attorney, Supt. of Highways, Town Clerk, Assessors, Clerk to the Assessors, members of the Town Planning Board and the Consultant to the Town Planning Board be authorized to attend the Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns to be held in the City of New York from February 16 to 18, 1949 and that all necessary expenses be paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that Supervisor Kelly be designated the Official Delegate to the Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns and that Justice Warner be designated the Alternate Delegate. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, January 19, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
