

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 3, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on February 16, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

The Supervisor's report for the month of February, 1949 was read and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of February was read and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of February 16, 1949 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from William O. Good submitting his resignation as a Special Policeman at Wading River to become effective on March 31, 1949. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the resignation of William O. Good as Special Policeman at Wading River be accepted, effective March 31, 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

A communication was read from the Davey Tree Expert Co. stating the number of trees that they would trim and prune in the Town of Riverhead for the sum of \$1,000.00. On motion and vote the matter was ordered placed on the calendar for the next Town Board meeting.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead purchase a strip of land from Joseph Danielowicz for the purpose of widening Osborn Avenue as shown on a certain Map made by Alden W. Young, C.E. dated January 29, 1949 for the sum of \$150.00. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Mico Art Bronze Company the sum of \$596.10, said sum being one-half of the gross receipts received from the parking meters during the month of February, 1949, pursuant to the agreement between the Mico Art Bronze Co. and the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it

was resolved that the Town of Riverhead enter into a contract with the Harder Extermination Service for the extermination of rats at the Riverhead Town Dump for a sum of \$600.00 per year, payable at \$50.00 per month. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 16, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
