

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 16, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 2, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Harry G. Penny, Sec. of the Riverhead Fire Department recommending certain parking regulations on East Second Street adjacent to the Fire House. The matter was referred to the Riverhead Police Chief for study and report.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice ^{Warner} Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$1409.00 from the Current Surplus Account to the Town Board/Retirement System Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the proposal of The F. A. Bartlett Tree Expert Company for the care of certain trees within the Town of Riverhead by letter dated February 2, 1949 for the sum of \$1000.00 be accepted. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik, it was Resolved that Chief of Police, John Doscinski or anyone he may designate be authorized to attend the Annual Safety Convention and Exposition of the Greater New York Safety Council to be held March 29th through April 1st, 1949 at the Hotel Statler, New York, N.Y. and that all necessary expense be paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A petition signed by sixteen residents and taxpayers requesting that sidewalks be layed on Sweezy Avenue from Parkway Street to Osborn Avenue was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to borrow the sum of \$4,000.00 on a Budget Note for a period of ten months for the purpose of paying the expenses incurred for snow removal. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

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On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to erect approximately 95 feet of wire fence in Grangebél Park from the rear boundary line of the Riberio property off Peconic Avenue. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town and Highway machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on April 6, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
