

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 6, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on Wednesday, March 16, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Jamesport-South Jamesport Civic Association requesting the Board to petition the State Traffic Commission to create a 30 miles per hour speed zone one half mile east and west of the Jamesport Traffic Light on Route 25. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that a request be made of the New York State Traffic Commission to create a 30 miles per hour "Speed Zone" one half mile east and west of the intersection of South Jamesport Avenue and State Highway Route #25 along Route #25 at Jamesport, Suffolk County, New York. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Mico Art Bronze Company the sum of \$807.56, said sum being one-half of the gross receipts received from the parking meters during the month of March, 1949 pursuant to an agreement between the Mico Art Bronze Co. and the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the amount of \$150.00 from the Current Surplus Account to the Miscellaneous and Contingent/Acquisition of Land Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the matter of widening and straightening Pulaski Street be referred to the Riverhead Town Planning Board. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that some sort of dedication of Grangabel Park be arranged for Memorial Day. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

Supervisor Kelly appointed Justice Yousik and Justice Zaleski as a Committee to arrange for the dedication of Grangabel Park on Memorial Day.

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A communication was read from the Riverhead Town Zoning Commission stating that it had invited certain townsmen in the field of real estate activities to meet with them on April 11, 1949, at 8:00 P.M. to discuss the problems of zoning and invited the Town Board to attend. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the Riverhead Yacht Club stating that it had adopted a resolution to the effect that the Town Board of Riverhead should insert in the next budget, the sum of \$5,000.00, for the improvement of water ways, docks and facilities, bulkheading and waterway facilities in the Town of Riverhead. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the request of the Polish National Alliance for permission to use the ground in the rear of the highway barn from May 30th to June 4th, 1949 be granted, provided that the grounds be left as clean as when entered upon and the necessary liability insurance be posted and further that the space to be used is to be designated by the Supt. of Highways. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A petition signed by 44 residents and taxpayers of Jamesport, N.Y. requesting the Board to lay a side-walk from the stores west to Tuthill's Path along the Main Road in Jamesport. The petition was ordered placed on file.

The Police Report for the month of March 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of April 1, 1949 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town and highway machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, April 20, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
