

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 20, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on April 6, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication from The Travelers Insurance Company making four recommendations to eliminate possible hazards in the Town was read and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file. The communication was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

A written complaint from R. Condon Smith and Mrs Burton Griffing, through the Police Department in regard to the damage of flowers, plants and other property in the rear of 131-133 West Main Street, requesting that some measures be taken to prevent trespassing and further damage and theft of flowers and shrubs was submitted to the Board. The communication was ordered placed on file.

Mr. R. Condon Smith, Attorney, appeared personally before the Board confirming the above complaint, further stating that there is no way at present for people to know where the boundary line between Grangable Park and private property is. He urged the Board to do something about it.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to negotiate with Burton Griffing to bear one-half of the expense of erecting a fence between his property and Grangable Park. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to erect approximately 260 feet of wire fence along the property of Sylvester Cavanaro adjacent to the Econic River Parking Field, for the sum not to exceed \$590.49. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

A petition for a sidewalk on Ostrander Avenue was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

A communication was read from Harry Tennenberg advising the Board that the sidewalk in front of his store on Griffing Avenue has been settling for some time and now has become very dangerous. The matter was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

The Supervisor's report for the month of March 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

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The Tax Receiver's report as of April 16, 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, May 4, 1949 at 3:00 P.M.
