

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, July 6, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on June 22, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Mr. Jay Hulse representing the Wildwood Property Owners Association addressed the Board and requested that refuse retainers be placed at their beach and that they be picked up once a week, that Beach Road be widened or make some provision for a parking field. He also requested full time police protection for Wildwood. The matters were referred to the Highway Committee and Supt. of Highways and the Police Committee and Chief of Police respectively.

A communication was read from Mrs George McGill of 90-25-205 St., Hollis, N.Y. in regard to an accident which occurred at the Wading River Beach on June 27, 1949. The Town Clerk was instructed to acknowledge receipt of the letter and advise that the matter has been referred to our Insurance Company.

The Police Report for the month of June 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A petition signed by seventeen residents and taxpayers requesting that a sidewalk be laid on Harrison Avenue north from the intersection of Osborn Avenue was submitted to the Board and referred to the Highway Committee and Supt. of Highways.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the hours during which the parking meters are to be enforced be changed from 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M., effective August 1, 1949 and further Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to expend the sum not to exceed \$250.00 to change the plates on the parking meters indicating the new hours. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that any person who obtains a permit to open any town highway shall deposit the sum of \$25.00 with the Superintendent of Highways to insure the replacement of the broken road to the satisfaction of the Supt. of Highways, said deposit to be held for a period of 30 days from the date the job is finished. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

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On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Michaels Art Bronze Company the sum of \$846.18, said sum being one-half the gross receipts from the parking meters during the month of June 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, July 20, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
