

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 7, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 17, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place 100 C.P. street lights on Poles Nos. 72, 68, 65, 62 and 59 on Hulse Landing Road in the Wading River Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place six 600 C.P. street lights in the Roanoke-Griffing Avenue Parking Field in the Riverhead Lighting District as per plan submitted. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Michael Art Bronze Company the sum of \$970.86, said sum being one-half of the gross receipts from the parking meters during the month of August 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Mr. Francis Creighton addressed the Board in regard to the parking problem on Marcy Avenue. He felt that if parking was restricted to one side of the Street, it would relieve the situation. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the application of Jay Hulse of Wading River, N.Y. to operate a vacation camp in the vicinity of Wildwood be granted. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that a public hearing be held at the Town Hall, corner of Second Street and Roanoke Avenue, Riverhead, N.Y. on the 21st day of September 1949 at 2:00 P.M. on the question of amending Town Ordinance No. 13 relating to the regulation of parking vehicles on public streets and highways by parking meters and as amended by enacting and adopting an ordinance for that purpose, and be it further

RESOLVED that notice of such hearing describing in general terms

said proposed ordinance as amended be given by publication thereof once in the Riverhead News and County Review at least ten days prior to the date of such hearing. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Communications were read from New York State Public Service Commission in regard to the petitions of Louis A. Fuoco and Henry W. and Vitus F. Adelwerth for certificates of public convenience and necessity for the temporary operation of omnibus lines between the Village of Patchogue and the Town of Riverhead, giving notice that a public hearing will be held in the above matter before the Commission at 233 Broadway, New York, N.Y. on Thursday, September 8, 1949 at 10:30 A.M., also a notice of a public hearing upon the petition of Burkhard Seidenschwarz to discontinue operation of his bus line between Patchogue and Riverhead to be held at the same place, day and hour as above. The communications were ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the New York State Traffic Commission advising that pursuant to authority conferred by Article 7 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, the Commission restricts to 35 MPH the speed at which vehicles may proceed on Route 25, SH 8066, between Station 1030-00 and Station 1101-00 a distance of 7100 feet in the unincorporated Village of Riverhead. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's report for the month of August 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of August 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to attend a Convention of the Superintendents of Highways at Rochester, N.Y. and that all necessary expenses be paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$5798.81 from the General Surplus Account to the following Highway Accounts:

#3 Machinery	\$ 650.00
#4 Miscellaneous	5148.81

The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 21, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
