

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 5, 1949 at 3:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 21, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Proof of publication and affidavit of posting the Parking Meter Ordinance which was adopted on September 21, 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Michael Art Bronze Company the sum of \$737.85, said sum being one-half of the gross receipts during the month of September 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that there shall be no turning around ^{of motor vehicles} on Mill Road from the northern entrance of the L.I. Cauliflower Association Auction Block to the intersection of Middle Road and Mill Road and further Resolved that there shall be no standing nor parking of motor vehicles on the easterly side Mill Road from the northerly entrance of the L.I. Cauliflower Association Auction Block to the intersection of Middle Road and Mill Road. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication from Francis R. Creighton, Fire Chief of the Riverhead Fire Department inviting the Board to participate in a short parade in conjunction with their program on the night of October 12th at 7:00 P.M. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mr. Lee Elwood requesting the Board to place a street light on Pole #30 at the corner of Eton Street and Fishel Avenue in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Report for the month of September 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to enter into an agreement with Everett DeFriest to repair the bulkhead at the head of Meeting House Creek for the sum not to exceed \$2200.00, said contract subject to the approval of the Town Attorney. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved, that the Town Board does hereby grant to the Supt. of Highways of the Town of Riverhead the power and authority to construct a sidewalk on the northerly side of Main Road (State Highway, Route #25) at Jamesport, N.Y. from Sta. 26+30 (east line of Tuthill Ave.) to Sta. 78+22 (approx. 400 ft. west of Manor Lane) as shown on plans prepared by Daniel R. Young, P.E. & L.S., March 3, 1945, entitled "New York State Postwar Planning Commission, Serial No. 1944, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, Town-wide Sidewalk Project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the State of New York and/or its agents, servants and employees shall not be liable for injuries to persons and/or property, not caused by the State of New York, its agents, servants or employees, which may occur during the repairing and/or building by the Riverhead Town Supt. of Highways of the aforesaid sidewalk. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved, that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place a 100 C.P. light on Pole #10 on Elton Street, transfer light from Pole #11 to Pole #12 on Elton Street, Place 100 C.P. light on Pole #25 on Ostrander Avenue Ext., place 100 C.P. light on Pole #20 on the corner of Fishel Ave. and Elton Street in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A request for "No Parking" on the south side of Court Street from Osborn Ave. to Griffing Ave. was discussed by the Board and referred to the Police Committee and the Chief of Police.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all bills to date, the totals of which are as follows: General Town - \$1933.34, Water District - \$3248.43, Highway Machinery - \$3675.66.

Pursuant to Section 111 of the Town Law, a detailed estimate of the amount of revenues to be received and the amount of expenditures to be made during the next fiscal year for every administrative officer, Board, Department and Commission of the Town of Riverhead was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were ordered placed on file as follows:
