

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, November 2, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 19, 1949 and minutes of the budget hearing on October 26, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Michaels Art Bronze Company the sum of \$760.75, said sum being one-half of the gross receipts from the parking meters during the month of October, 1949. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Report for the month of October, 1949 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Zaleski

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors of Suffolk County have by resolution set up a fund known as the Beach Maintenance Fund to provide for the maintenance of beach protection structures built under the provisions of Chapter 535, Laws of 1945 as amended and,

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors have also, subject to the approval of the respective Town Boards, provided that one-half the cost of the said maintenance work be charged back, in the next roll, to the Town in which the said maintenance work is done, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town of Riverhead approves the County resolution providing for the maintenance of beach protection structures and be it further

RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Town of Riverhead to share in the cost of such maintenance to the extent of 50% of the cost of said construction completed in the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place 100 C.P. street lights on Poles #146, 150, 153, 156, 159, 162, 165 and 168 on Peconic Bay Boulevard in the South Jamesport Lighting District, Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills, the total of which are as follows: General Town Fund \$4,344.69, Highway Machinery Fund \$95.36, Water District Fund \$351.09.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 16, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.
