

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 31, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 7, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the resolution which was duly adopted on December 7, 1949 in regard to a public hearing on the matter of the Riverhead Fire Protection District Contracts be and the same is hereby rescinded. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead request Harry T. Tuthill, County Superintendent of Highways to release the sum of \$5000.00 from the Highway Reserve Fund, Item #1, Town of Riverhead, to be used for general maintenance of highways during the remainder of the year. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from The Long Island Association asking the Town to advertise in thier 15th Edition, "LONG ISLAND-THE SUNRISE HOMELAND" for publication early in 1950, guaranteed distribution of 16000 copies. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead advertise in the 15th Edition, "LONG ISLAND-THE SUNRISE HOMELAND" for 1950 and that the sum not to exceed \$300.00 be expended for such advertising. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of Taxes collected as of December 16, 1949 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the totals of which are as follows: General Town Fund \$1827.27; Highway Machinery Fund \$415.42; Riverhead Sewer \$949.77; Riverhead Water District Fund \$460.36.


The bids were ordered placed on file.
