

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 24, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Superintendent of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 10, 1948 and on March 17, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the appointment of John Gatz as Town Constable and part time Police Patrolman be terminated, effective as of March 31, 1948. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Leonard,

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission has submitted an eligible list for the positions of Police Patrolmen for the Town of Riverhead, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that John Gatz be appointed Police Patrolman of the Town of Riverhead in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission, salary fixed at the base rate of \$2600.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly, effective as of April 1, 1948, and further

RESOLVED, that Chester S. Romanski be appointed Police Patrolman of the Town of Riverhead in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission, salary fixed at the base rate of \$2300.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly, effective as of April 1, 1948. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor be directed and authorized to make application to the New York State Youth Commission for its approval of the Town of Riverhead to continue in the New York State Youth Program. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town then audited the Highway Machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, April 7, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.
