

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 15, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 1, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Mr. Henry Ohlhurst addressed the Board calling their attention to the situation of the easterly portion of the Highway Island at the intersection of State Highway #35 and County Highway #58.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead request the New York State Dept. of Public Works and the Suffolk County Highway Department to make an immediate survey and study of the easterly portion of the Highway Island at the intersection of State Highway #25 and County Highway #58 in the Town of Riverhead, New York. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Riverhead Fire Department Budget for the next fiscal year was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that a title search be made of the Griffing Park property. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead negotiate with the Western Union Telegraph Company for a clock in the Supervisor's Office at a rental of \$18.00 per year. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$100.00 from the General Town Current Surplus Account to the Riverhead Town Zoning Commission Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Police Chief be authorized to attend the International Association of Chief's of Police to be held at the Pennsylvania Hotel, New York, N.Y. from October 10-14, 1948 with all necessary expenses paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Zaleski it

was Resolved that the Superintendent of Highways be authorized to attend the New York State Highway Commissioner's Convention to be held at Rochester, New York with all necessary expenses paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, October 6, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.
