

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 23, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on January 8, 1947 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Joseph E. Walsh requesting that a street light be placed on East Avenue between the Railroad and Northville Turnpike. The communication was referred to the Street Lighting Committee.

A communication was read from the Long Island Association in regard to their "Booklet" published each year advertising the towns and villages of Suffolk County and asked whether or not the Town of Riverhead wished to participate in this advertising campaign.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead advertise in the "Booklet" published by the Long Island Association in 1947 ^{and a sum not to exceed} a sum not to exceed \$200.00. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that Bond No 360532 of the Glens Falls Indemnity Company bonding Henry M. Zaleski, Justice of the Peace, Town of Riverhead in the amount of \$1000.00 be and the same is hereby approved as to form manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead acquire for the purpose of altering and widening the approach to the proposed construction of the Manor Bridge on River Road between the Towns of Riverhead and Brookhaven from Jezy Krupski and Sadie Krupski, the owners thereof, three parcels of land fronting on David Terry Street and the Riverhead Manor Road designated as parcels A, B, and C. together with the fill easement along said Parcel A as shown on a certain map showing Right of Way and Fill Easement Area to be acquired from Jezy and Sadie Krupski by the Town of Riverhead for the reconstruction of David Terry Street, Manorville, Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk, New York, made by F. Shaffer, dated October 1944 and that the Town cause to be abandoned as a Highway that part of David Terry Street bounded on the southwest by a line extending from the southeast corner of Parcel B to the northeast corner of Parcel A; on the east by Peconic River, on the northeast

by the present north line of said street extending from southeast corner of Parcel A to Peconic River (a survey to be made of the same and a more accurate description to be prepared therefrom) and to quit claim its title and interest thereto to said Jezy Krupski and Sadie Krupski his wife and be it further


RESOLVED that for the purpose aforesaid the Town pay to said Jezy Krupski and Sadie Krupski the sum of \$200.00. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that Marion C. Worth be and she hereby is appointed Temporary Clerk to the Board of Assessors, said appointment at the pleasure of the Town Board, salary fixed at the rate of \$5.00 per day. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place a 250 C.P. street lamp on the pole at the corner of Roanoke Avenue and Fifth Street in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, February 5, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.
