

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 15, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 1, ^{+ Oct. 8.} 1947 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town Board does hereby grant to the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead the power and authority to construct a sidewalk on the northerly side of Main Road (State Highway Route #25) at Jamesport, N.Y., from station 62 - 95 (east line of property of O.A. Hawkins) to Station 119 - 60 (west line of Herrick Lane) as shown on plans prepared by Daniel R. Young, P.E. & L.S., March 3, 1945, entitled "New York State Postwar Planning Commission, Serial No. 1944, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, Town-wide Sidewalk Project", and be it further

RESOLVED, that the State of New York and/or its agents, servants, and employees shall not be liable for injuries to persons and/or property, not caused by the State of New York, its agents, servants or employees, which may occur during the repairing and/or building by the Riverhead Town Superintendent of Highways of the aforesaid sidewalk. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The Supervisors report for the month of September 1947 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of September 1947 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Yousik

WHEREAS a portion of a certain town highway known as Park Road, particularly described in a certain certificate of abandonment dated October 15, 1947 has never been opened as a highway and has never been used or worked as such, and

WHEREAS H.E.Griffin the adjoining owner claims title to said portion and other lands within the bounds of said highway adjacent to said above mentioned portion and

WHEREAS the claim of title of said H.E.Griffin is recognized as having some merit and the portion of said highway to be abandoned serves no useful purpose as a town highway, now there fore be it

RESOLVED that the portion of said highway described in said certificate of abandonment dated October 15, 1947 be abandoned and that said certificate be executed by the proper town officials and be it further
said

RESOLVED that delivery of/certificate of abandonment be made upon receipt of a quit claim deed from H.E.Griffin to the Town of Riverhead for that portion of said Park Road adjacent to and bounded southerly by the aforesaid abandoned portion, easterly by Riverhead Town Park and westerly by said Park Road and that said abandonment shall not be effective until the execution and delivery of said quit claim deed. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town and Highway machinery bills to date.

There being no futher business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 5, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.
