

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 23, 1946 at 3:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on Wednesday, October 7, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Riverhead Chamber of Commerce together with a resolution stating that the Chamber wishes to go on record of favoring the idea of a parking area on the north side of Peconic River and that a further study and investigation be made on this project. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that there is no objection on the part of the Town of Riverhead to the satisfaction of the Tax Receiver's Bond on the 1945-1946 tax collections, provided the audit by the County Treasurer shows no objection thereto. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A petition signed by several taxpayers of Roanoke Heights requesting the Board to lay a sidewalk on Merritts Pond Road, East of Roanoke Ave. The petition was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

A communication was read from Alba Tomlinson and Edna S. Lawson notifying the Board that they elect to terminate their lease with the Town of Riverhead, dated April 1, 1946, in accordance with the terms of said lease. Said termination to be effective January 1, 1947. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to approve the application of Alba Tomlinson and Edna Lawson of the termination of the lease with the Town of Riverhead, dated April 1, 1946, upon the condition that the entire rental of \$200.00 be refunded to the Town. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted his final report on the 1945-1946 tax collection and on motion and vote the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of

\$338.69 from the Current Surplus Account to the following accounts:

Town Board/Other Expense \$330.00

Town Board/Insurance/Fire &
Liability 8.69

The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from Mrs Kathryn M. Newins stating that she agrees to permit the Town of Riverhead to use a portion of her property to within three feet of the barn in connection with the existing parking field. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 6, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.
