

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 2, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 25, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication from Supervisor Kelly certifying that he had received from Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes the sum of \$209.21, for penalties in full of tax collections of the 1945-46 Tax Warrant. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of September 1946 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Leonard

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Civil Service/List for the positions of Police Patrolmen in the Town of Riverhead, having been canvassed, pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead on September 25, 1946, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Stephen J. Grodski, John R. McGoey, Chester J. Kowalsky, John J. Harris, A. John Doscinski, Harold M. Bowden, William J. Danowski, Robert G. Leonard and Oliver Halsey Corwin, taken from the Civil Service Eligible List, be and they hereby are appointed Police Patrolmen of the Town of Riverhead, said appointments effective as of October 16, 1946, salary fixed at the base rate of \$2200.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The Vote, Justice Zaleski absent, Justices Warner, Yousik and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 4, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was RESOLVED that A. John Doscinski be provisionally appointed as Chief of Police of the Town of Riverhead, effective as of October 16, 1946 at an additional salary of \$500.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The Vote, Justice Zaleski absent, Justices Warner, Yousik and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 4, No.0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it

was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place 2 80 C.P. street lights on Poles No. 2 and 6 in the Wading River Lighting District, Town of Riverhead. Said lights to be reflector lights in order to cast light into the adjacent parking field. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that J. Fred Dugan and Frank J. Smith be authorized to appraise the remaining parcels of land along Peconic River to Mc Dermott Avenue and further Resolved that Alden W. Young L.S. be authorized to prepare the necessary map. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Pursuant to Section 111 of the Town Law, detailed estimates of the amount of revenues to be received and the amount of expenditures to be made during the next fiscal year for every administrative officer, board department and commission of the Town of Riverhead was submitted to the Town Board and on motion and vote were ordered placed on file as follows:
