

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 6, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on February 19, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Supervisor Kelly submitted reports for the months of January and February, 1946 and on motion and vote were accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of February, 1946 was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

Forrest G. Downs, Rec. of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of March 1, 1946 and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

A Safety Committee composed of the Supervisor, Police Committee, Highway Committee and the Chief of Police after due study and inspection of the various intersections of the Town, recommended that the Supt. of Highways place several full stop signs and white lines at various places which in their opinion would help to eliminate traffic accidents.

The matter of adequate parking facilities for the Town was discussed at length by the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Supervisor and the Town Attorney be authorized to negotiate with the owners for the purchase of the property between Roanoke Avenue and Griffing Avenue, now rented by the Town, for use as a permanent parking field. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor and the Town Attorney be authorized to negotiate with the owners of the property in the rear of the East Diner and the Sears Roebuck Store on the South-side of East Main Street for a term lease to be used as a parking field. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Proof of publication of the notice of consideration by the Town Board of the purchase of a new highway truck pursuant to Section 142 of the Highway Law was submitted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to purchase one four wheel drive Walters Snow Fighter at a price not to exceed the sum of \$11,280.00. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$20.22 from the Current Surplus Account to the Budgetary Control Municipal Indebtedness Interest Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wedneaday, March 20, 1946 at 2:00.
