

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 28, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.

The matter in regard to acquiring the several properties in the rear of the business section of the Town on East Main Street along Peconic River for a permanent Town Parking Field was brought to the attention of the Board.

Mr. J. Leo Saxstein, Attorney, representing Mr. Sylvester Cavanaro addressed the Board and spoke at length in opposing the above project.

Mrs M.N. Ammann, representing the Riverhead Garden Club and Mrs I.M. Young, representing the Riverhead Womens' Club both addressed the Board and urged that the above mentioned property be acquired by the Town for the purpose of a Town Parking Field and Town Park.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that J. Fred Dugan and Frank J. Smith be authorized to appraise the several parcels of land in the rear of the business section of the of the Town on East Main Street, east of Peconic Avenue for the purpose of negotiating for the purchase of the property for use as a permanent Town Parking Field. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that Alden W. Young L.S. be authorized to prepare a map of the above mentioned property as proposed for a Town Parking Field. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways recommended that the following concretessidewalks be laid: north side of East Second Street, north side of Lincoln Street west of Roanoke Avenue, and west side of Hamilton Avenue from Lincoln Street to Parkway Street and that the rest of the 1946 allotment for sidewalks to be used at Jamesport.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 11, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.
