

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 3, 1945 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 29, 1944 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the New York State Association of Towns giving notice that the thirteenth annual meeting of the Association will be held at Albany, New York on Thursday and Friday February 15th and 16th, 1945. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Leonard it was resolved that Joseph V. Kelly, Supervisor be designated the official delegate to represent the Town of Riverhead at the 13th Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns at Albany, New York, New York on February 15th and 16th, 1945, and further resolved that Austin H. Warner be designated the official alternate delegate. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Supervisor, the four Justices of the Peace, Town Attorney, Supt. of Highways, the three Assessors, Clerk to the Board of Assessors and Town Clerk be authorized to attend the 13th Annual Meeting of the New York State Association of Towns to be held at Albany, New York, on February 15th and 16th, 1945, and that each be allowed the sum not to exceed \$60.00 for necessary expenses. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of Taxes collected as of January 2, 1945 and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of December 1944 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mr. Nugent M. George in regard to the right-of-way from Riverside Drive to the Riverhead Sewer District Disposal Plant and on motion and vote was referred to the Town Attorney.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Wells H. Halse, Sound Avenue, Riverhead, N.Y. be

and he hereby is appointed Dog Enumerator in and for the Town of Riverhead for the year of 1945, salary fixed by the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from Daniel R. Young, Surveyor, in regard to the Post War Townwide Sidewalk Project, Serial #1944, stating that he has completed over fifty per-cent of the plans to date. The communication was ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Kelly appointed the following Town Committees:


Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways addressed the Board stating that many times he has had to work his men over 8 hours a day in order to finish his work and that the State Labor Board called his attention to the fact that if his men do work over 8 hours per day, they are entitled to time and a half pay. He recommended that an hourly increase in the wages of his employees be made and that he would place them on an 8 hour a day basis.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the wages of the Town Highway Employees be approved on an 8 hour a day basis as follows: Emil Stakey at \$1.15 per hr., Stanley Brant at 1.10, Fenimore Corwin at 1.05, W. Roy Hooper at 1.15 John Zaleski at 1.05, Edmund Buziak at .90, John Welch at .90, Edwin Arnold at .90, Carl Corwin at .90, Fred Corwin at .90, Charles Downs at .95 Paul Lutski at .90, William Donovan at .95, Daniel McBride at .80, Felix Bilski at .75, Konstanty Klodoski at .75, Warren Bechtel at .75, and Clarence Hawkins at .70, John Sieminski at 1.00, George Condzella at .90, Alex Horton at .90 and Joseph Danielowich at .90. All temporary laborers at .70. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Suffolk County Trust Company, Suffolk County National Bank and the Long Island State Bank and Trust Company be and they hereby are designated the depositories of all moneys of the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, January 17, 1945 at 2:00 P.M.
