

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday July 15, 1942 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on July 1, 1942 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Smith it was resolved that Lorimer M. Raynor be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Supervisor of School Districts Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11 in the Town of Riverhead, and be it further

Resolved, that Katheryne Van Nostrand be and she hereby is appointed Attendance Supervisor of School Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 12 and 13 in the Town of Riverhead, and be it further

Resolved, that the compensation of each Attendance Supervisor be fixed at the rate of \$250.00 per school year, payable monthly, which compensation shall include all expenses other than those incurred when attending meetings outside of the Town of Riverhead, called by the District Superintendent of Schools, at which time actual expenses are to be paid by the Town of Riverhead. The Vote, Justices Zaleski, Smith, Warner and Butcher Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was resolved that John Muller of Wildwood, New York be appointed Special Policeman in and for the Town of Riverhead, to serve at the pleasure of the Town Board, salary fixed at the rate of 50 cents per hour. The Vote, Justices Zaleski, Smith, Warner and Butcher Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Butcher it was resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$301.20 from the Current Surplus Account to the Insurance Account for the purpose of paying War Damage Insurance. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's report for the month of June 1942 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A report of the Welfare Department for the month of June 1942 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.


The matter in regard to the condition of the sidewalk in front of the old Riverhead Theatre on Main Street was brought to the attention of the

Board and was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

A committee composed of Justice Smith and Justice Warner was appointed to contact the proper authorities in charge of the Odd Fellows Building in regard to janitor service, toilets, water fountain etc. for the Town Hall quarters.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Welfare bills for the month of June 1942.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, August 5, 1942 at 2:00 P.M.
