

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 19th, 1941 at 2:00 P. M.

Justice Warner was duly elected Chairman of the meeting.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 5th, 1941 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Clyde Tooker in regard to the surface water drain on Riverside Drive and relative to his communications of May 29th and July 31st, 1936. The communication was ordered placed on file and the matter referred to the Highway Committee.

A letter of appreciation from Mrs. Julian Rubenstein was read and ordered placed on file.

A certified copy of an order of the Public Service Commission adopted March 4th, 1941, Case No. 10373, petition of Thomas J. Quinn together with a copy of a report (Cases 10372 and 10373) dated February 10th, 1941, approved by the Commission, March 4th, 1941 were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were ordered placed on file.


A report of Forrest G. Downs, showing the amount of Taxes collected as of March, 17, 1941 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The matter in regard to additional office space for the Riverhead Water District was discussed by the Board.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the Water District Committee together with the Manager of the Water District be empowered to partition the space in the rear of the Justice's Court Room to be used as an office for the Riverhead Water District. The vote, Supervisor Sawyer, absent, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Zaleski, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Welfare bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on April 2, 1941 at 2:00 P. M.
