

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, October 1st, 1940 at 2:00 P. M.

Solomon Raffe, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 18th, 1940 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that the Long Island Lighting Co. be authorized to place 13 - 80 C. P. street lights on North Wading River Road in the Wading River Lighting District beginning on Pole #62 and ending on pole #97 at the intersection of North Wading River Road and Hulse Landing Road. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Zaleski, Yes, Supervisor Sawyer, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Kelly offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Boutcher

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead, New York, requires loam for the repair of roads in said Town, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead, has an option to purchase certain land from Franklin H. Young which contains a large quantity of loam, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Elmer J. B. Sawyer, as Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead, is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into a contract on behalf of the Town of Riverhead with Franklin H. Young for the purchase of eight acres of land from said Franklin H. Young at a cost not to exceed \$1,800.00, to be paid as follows: \$900.00 on or about January 15th, 1941 and \$900.00 on or about January 15th, 1942. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Zaleski, Yes, Supervisor Sawyer, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Warner it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be authorized to appoint some one to obtain a traffic count on South Jamesport Avenue in the vicinity of the over-head Railroad crossing for a period of four days from 7:00 A. M. to 6:00 P. M. for the sum not to exceed \$20.00. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Zaleski, Yes, Supervisor Sawyer, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that the following Annual Estimate of revenues and expenditures for the ensuing year be adopted


