

Minutes of a Special executive meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 19, 1938 at 9:00 A.M., pursuant to a resolution.

On motion and vote the reading of the minutes of a meeting held on January 12, 1938 were suspended until the next regular meeting of the Board.


Mr. Kelly, State Auditor addressed the Board explaining his duties, stating that he examines and audits the Highway accounts and makes final reports. He further stated that it is not his duty to prosecute any irregularities. If found, it is up to the Town itself to protect its interests. (He wished it noted in the minutes that the Highway accounts of the Town of Riverhead, as of January 1, 1938 were very well kept and in fine condition.)

Mr. Jay Neuman, State Auditor addressed the Board and stated that he examines and Audits Municipal accounts. Further stating that after examining and auditing the accounts of a municipality, he makes a final report, and from his criticisms and recommendations, it is up to the municipality itself to prosecute any irregularity.

The Board then discussed the Highway Law and the system under which the Highway Department operates.

The Town Board under advisement decided to withhold all statements until their next regular meeting on January 26, 1938 at which time a public statement would be made.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
